

Selsey to Chichester Cycle Route - Progress Report Jan 2019

Progress continues to be made in providing a safe cycle route suitable for commuting between Selsey and Chichester without having to brave the B2145. The Medmerry to RSPB section is built and opens at Easter. Funding is being sought for construction costs on the Golf Links Lane to Medmerry section and, if all goes well, that section should be built in 2020. In Sidlesham, landowner issues are being addressed and, in Hunston, matters are gradually being resolved to give a clear route via the Free School to the A27 footbridge. There are still impact assessments to be completed on some parts of the proposed route and funding for them is being sought. It has taken a long time to get this far, but the many groups and organisations that have been involved continue to get nearer to providing a safe cycle route between Selsey and Chichester.
